My dear Sara!

I have received your letter of March with the little photo of you and your mother with your draft, for which I thank you very much. My best thanks also to Harry Segall for his kindness, I and my mother send the best regards to him.

We are all well. Aunt Chiena is also well, she comes every day to us. She has given me a letter to you which I enclose with my one. She writes Jewish, but I think your mother must read Jewish.

At the 20th July I am becoming my furlough and I am going for three weeks to the sea to rest from my work. I have worked very hard the last months. Our cousin Jente (^{she is now in Siauliai} I don't know how to spell this name, she is a daughter from our aunt Goldes) and the other sister Feige is now living in our town and we see each other very often. They both send their best regards to you!

Regards to all our relations, my mother
and sister send also their regard to you,
your mother and every member of our
family.

I think I write very bad English, but
you will understand my letter and forgive
me for my mistakes.
